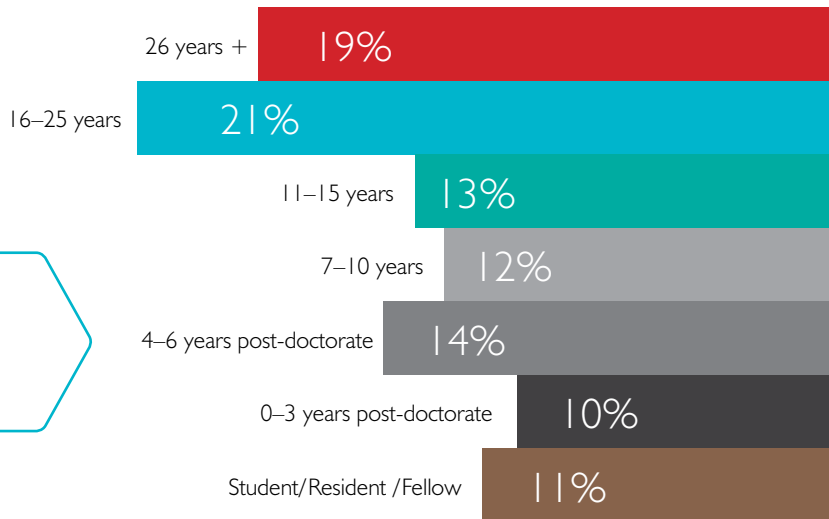

Career Stage

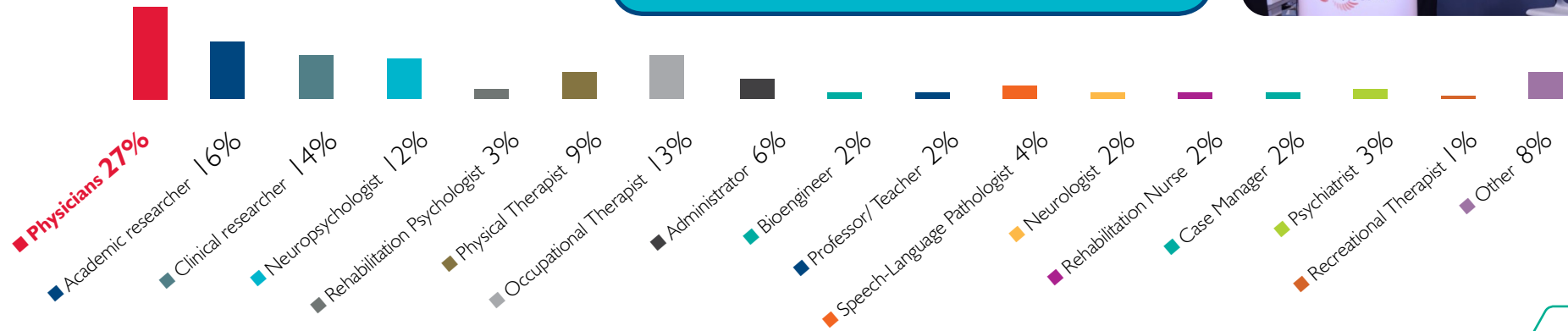


Statistics from 2012 - 2016 ACRM Annual Conference surveys

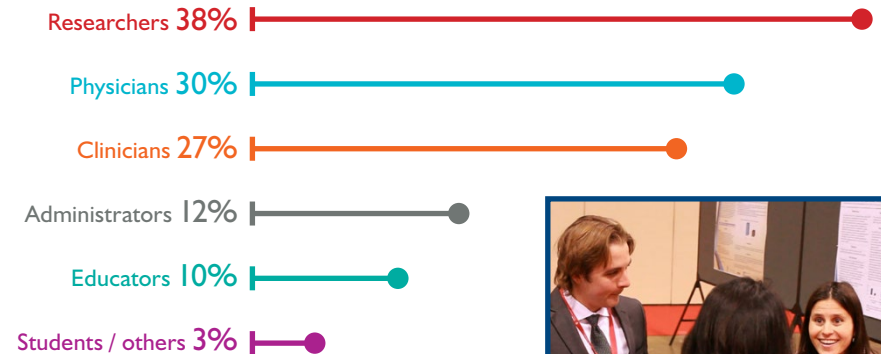

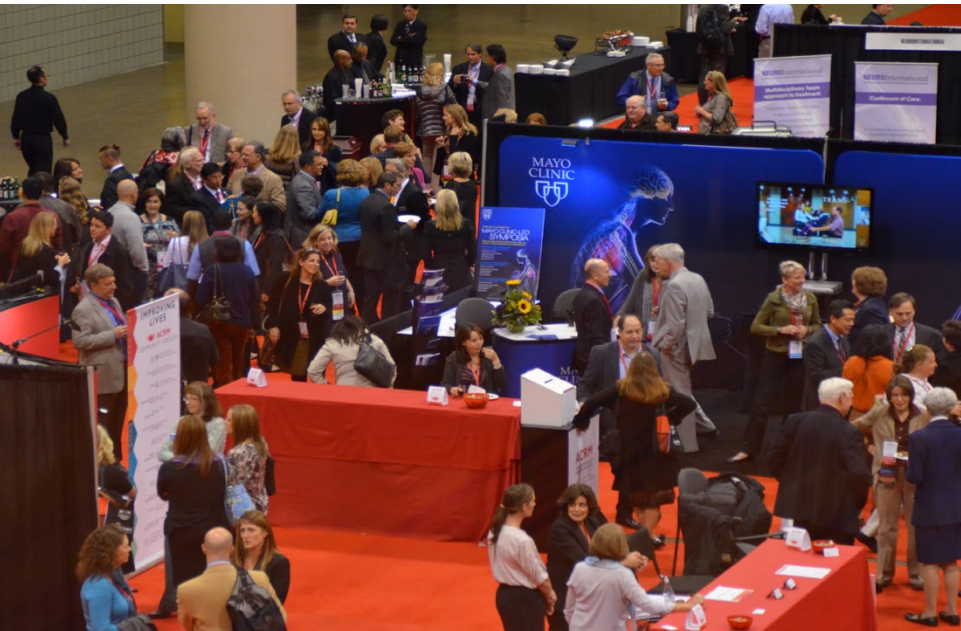

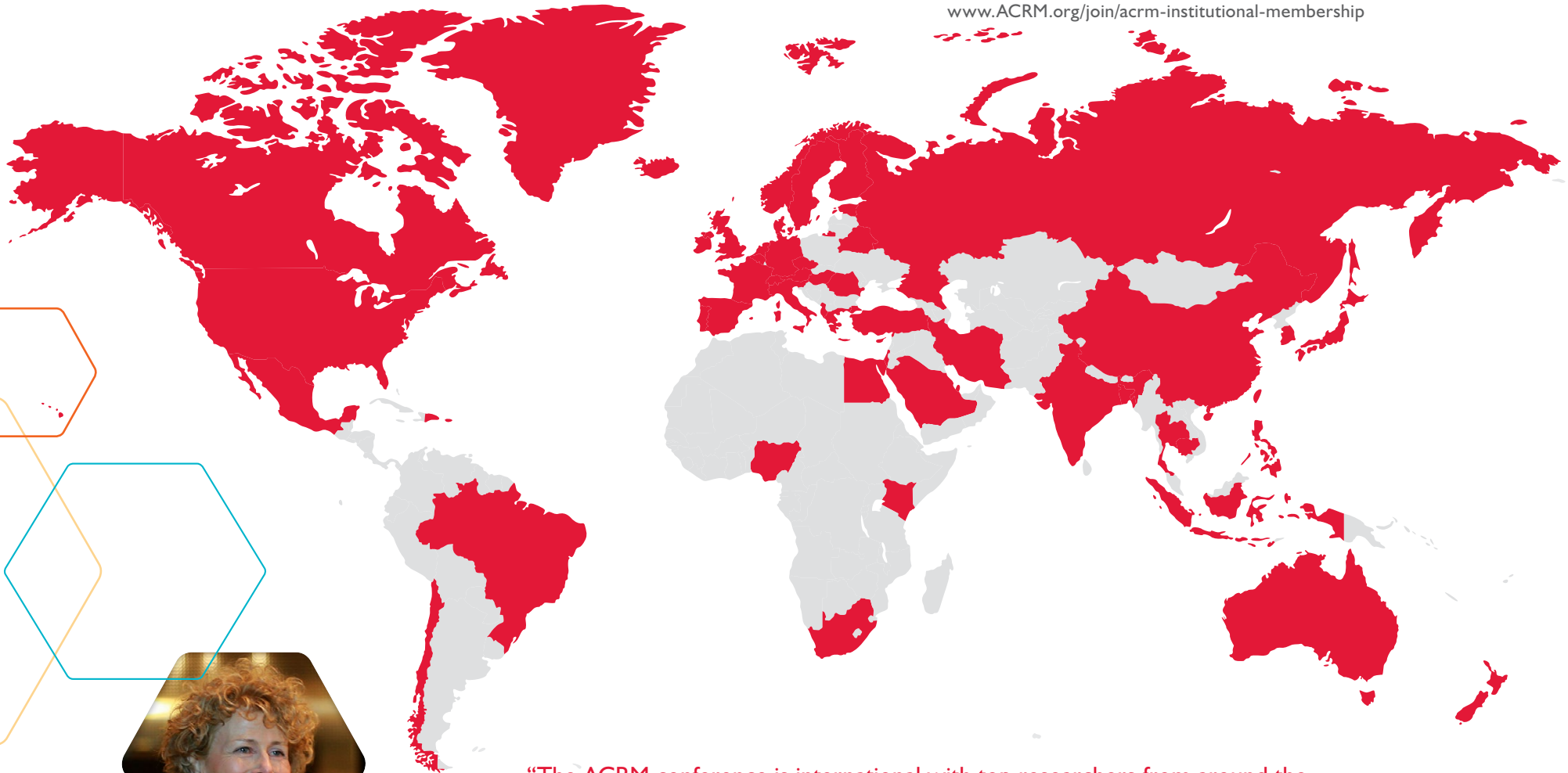
